Description of Aleurites brasiliensis, and A. triloba, and comparison with Margraf's genus Anda. {Foot-note appended to the title of the article refers to an earlier paper in Arsberätt. Läkare-Sällsk. Arbeten for 1823, p. 55, but this reference could not be identified.} However, at the bottom of that page begins a short note, reporting that L. Westin, the Swedish consul in Rio de Janeiro, has observed the use of a milky substance, called "andaisu" by the natives and derived from a coconut palm, used against dropsy. <sup>not identified sm</sup>
