⊗ Banks distinguishes between the wild ungrafted chestnut (châtaignier in French, which he uses) and the grafted or cultivated variety (maronnier) [maronnier] the article is about an experiment on the horticultural management of a number of grafted trees sent from Devon by Sir William Watson to Banks at Spring Grove. The practice of grafting chestnuts was not known in this country, except in some localities, i.e. Devon + western counties. Should it be included?
