Notes ⁷ Banks notice, so he says, is taken from an account of Lelieur's work in the Moniteur, 7 Dec. 1811. The present short article is on Le blanc, or mealy disease treated by Lelieur in his work. Banks adds that the work had not yet arrived in England. In fact I have found nothing specifically on diseases by Lelieur and think that such a work had not been published in France either, except perhaps as articles or memoirs, that the work which deals with this was published 4 years later in 1816 as La Pomone française. In this work, which I have checked at the Lindley, the material dealing with mealy disease, le blanc or le meunier, closely resembles all that Banks mentions in this article. As this deduction is indefinite, I have not made out an E form, for La Pomone, etc.

N.B. I have not checked Le Moniteur. (yet). You should have H-forms for 2 editions
