P, 32 gives the vegetable remains in the 'tough-ground' stratum, mainly oak trees. P. 33- above a stratum of silt a layer of leaves, hazel nuts, sticks and moss, 6-12" thick. This layer of vegetable matter was about 30 ft below the level of the sea at low water and about 48ft at spring tides [i.e. high tides].
