Notes (X) Mentions the practice in botany of honouring people by giving their names to new plants. The Empress Josephine's family name had been given by Ruis & Pavon to a South American plant; the Emperor had named a native plant of Australia Josephinia. The flower was related to the digitalia and pedaliu.

Palisot de Beauvois had given the Emperor's name to a tree he had discovered in Owara in Africa.
