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Notes (X) Résumé of work done by the Academicians during the 2nd semester of 1806.

Palisot de Beauvois had continued with the Flore d'Oware et de Benin; his researches into the cryptogams, especially into their method of fertilization; his ideas on the fertilization of mushrooms.

Candolle had presented 3 memoirs to the Académie: on parasitic fungi, on marine algae, and on the family Rubiaceae.

Dupetit-Thouars; As a result of his sojourns in the Îles de France and Bourbon, and his travel in Madagascar, he had made observations on the orchids, done work on ferns, his especial interest, and on dracoena. From the latter came his ideas on the general organization and development of trees.
