Schkuhr and Palisot de Beauvois: observations on the stigmata of the Cyperaceae.
P. de B: continuation of observations on the fertilization of mosses.
Dupetit-Thouars: on the connection between leaves and the woody layers of trees.
" on the relationship between the number of stamens and the number of other parts of the plant.
Desvaux presented a memoir on the algae; and work on the banana, the number of varieties he had found was 44.
The Marquis de Suffran had undertaken to examine and describe the different varieties of fig-tree which grew along the Mediterranean coast from Genoa to Perpignan for the benefit of Provençal cultivators.
Thiébaud de Berneaux, who proposed to translate the works of Theophrastus and who, to

recognise the plants mentioned in his works had undertaken to travel to the countries where they grew, had presented several results to the Classe.
Lamouroux had addressed the assembly on Thalassiophytes.
Saint-Hilaire had carried out work on several families of plants where the placenta is simple.
