Notes (X) Résumé of work done by :

Humboldt: had returned to his observations on the proportionate distribution of plant species in different climates, extending his research which he communicated to the Académie and which was published the same year in the Dictionnaire des Sciences naturelles.

Dupetit-Thouars: his opinions on a peculiarity in the oriental poppy, sent to him by the Abbé Rigaud. Description of the metamorphosis.

Dutrochet had addressed the Assembly of ^{Experimental} Plant Physiology (founded by M. de Montejon) on growth in trees and the function of lignous fibres; in the second part of the work he considered growth in monocotyledonous plants; in the third part, the reasons why stalks of plants should rise above the ground, while the roots descended.
