Dupetit-Thouars, who has presented a large work on the Orchidaceae, and 36 engraved plates of orchids belonging to the genus he called angorchis.

The work of three men, Cassini, Robert Brown, Richard on the family called Boopides or Calyceraceae.

Jaume Saint-Hilaire presented a memoir on the varieties and species of wheat. He numbered 60; he had also given a new work on the genera aspalathus, borbonia & liparia, on which he had delivered a memoir in 1813; a journey to England had increased the number by 22.

Richard (son) had read a memoir on hydrocotyle.

The Académie had seen plates of plants done by lithographic methods by M. Guyot and recognised its advantages over copper-engraving.
