Notes In addition to Cuvier, as the Permanent Secretary of the Academy, the report is signed by the five members of a special committee: Geoffroy Saint-Hilaire, Desfontaines, Latreille, Brongniart and de Jussieu. Augustin de Saint-Hilaire's collections are said to include a herbarium of 30,000 specimens representing nearly 7,000 species. New species may total as much as two thirds of this number, and among these ^{are} new genera and new families. One of these, Vochysiaceae, has already been published in the works of the Museum.
