FÉBURIER: who had presented a memoir to the Académie on the pith in plants.

DUPETIT-THOUARS: had been working on the composition of the principle nerves of the cotyledons, as well as on those of the roots of certain plants especially the cucurbitaceae.

SAINT-HILAIRE: continuation of his work on the gynobase; and also read his memoir "Histoire des plantes les plus remarquables du Brésil et du Paraguay comprenant leur description..."

MOOREAU de JONNÈS had proved that the Portuguese had taken manioc and maize to Africa and that they did not originate there.

MONGES had attempted to trace the citrus spoken of by the Romans.

BORY DE SAINT-VINCENT: had invented apparatus to dry off plants destined for the herbarium more quickly.
