① Résumé of work done by:

Gaudichaud, who had accompanied Freycinet on his voyage round the world and had presented a flora of the Malouin islands to the Académie. In spite of the sparseness of the vegetation of the islands they possessed 40 species which had not been found elsewhere.

Gaudichaud: observations on the cycas and on its marrow, sago.

Lamouroux: mention of his death; a few days prior to this he had presented a large work on the distribution of marine plants - résumé of this.

Delisle had continued his work on the natural history of lichens; the first part appeared in 1823; in a second memoir he treated the genus roccella.
