Dupetit-Thouars: stood by his theory of plant growth, i.e. that the bud is the beginning of the new plant. Abstract of his work.

Mirbel read to the Academie his memoir "Nouvelles recherches sur la structure et les développements de l'ovule végétale: abstract.

Dunal presented 2 memoirs 1) on the organs of the flower, 2) sought to establish the organs of colour and the glandular organs of the flower.

Cambessedes had taken up the study of the family sapindus with plantes brought back from Brazil by Saint-Hilaire.

Achille Richard proposed to examine closely the plants of the family rubiaceae.

Cassini: mention and short description of his work on composite flowers.

Candolle: work on the onagraceae, the paronychiaee, cactaceae, umbelliferae in his "Collection de mémoires pour servir à l'histoire du regne végétal" { Extracts of these works appeared in Bulletin universel, tom. 17, 18, 19. Editor Ferussac. }

Cambessedes had been obliged to take over the publication of Saint-Hilaire's "Flore du Brésil méridionale" because of the latter's ill-health.
