Notes {Doubleday at Trenton Falls.} ^(x) P. 26 contains details of the vegetation of the woods some distance from Utica. It included: 4 species of viola: V. Canadensis, V. rotundifolia, and 2 others not named; Trillium erectum & erythrocarpum, Uvularia grandiflora & sessiliflora, Claytonia virginica, Fumaria and nearly an acre of Cypripedium, also a saxifrage, which he thought to be S. virginiensis.
