Notes Davall's herbarium had been added to that of Dr. Smith. It had arrived from France on Nov. 2, 1802. Besides Davall's own herbarium were those which had belonged to Reynier and Favrod, both of which comprised mainly Swiss plants. Davall's was of European plants. Amongst these a new moss was found, discovered in Switzerland and which Smith named Gymnostomum Davallianum. Two line description follows this.
