Notes In autumn when leaves are shed one sees at the base of the pedicel a number of holes. These mark the severance of the filament, which are the veins, or rather, bunches of fibres. The scar on the bark where the leaf was detached shows the same holes. The filament can be followed through to the inside of the wood. Observations made in the spring show that the filaments do not reach the surface of the wood, it happens a few months after the development of the new leaf. The author has also made some "curious" remarks on the relation between the number of stamens and other parts of the flower. In some genus i.e. polygonum, rheum, where the relation seems very irregular, the number of stamens is equal to the sum of the divisions of the calyx and pistils taken together.
