Notes The Society had published a list of trees to be planted along the boulevards and in public places. 25 species were listed amongst them the following: field elm (orme des champs), American elm [Guazuma tomentosa?] ash, American ash, [Broussonetia papyrifera?] -paper mulberry, [Liriodendron?] -Tulipier, beech [Fagus sylvatica?] chestnut- [Castanea vulgaris?], lime with large leaves, silver lime, plane-tree, sycamore, maple, maple with ash type leaves, mottled maple, Canadian poplar, Italian poplar, Swiss poplar, catalpa, Japanese varnish-tree, service tree. birch, Tamarix.
