Bethune Houriez at Cambrai had sent to the Society 3 ears of seed which he called "riz de Cochinchine", but which M. Mauguin recognised as a triticum monococcum and not rice.

August de Courcelles (Lille) had sent several varieties of wheat and oats with a note indicating each variety, upon which he had made experiments. Jacquart, Broy and Descamps had cultivated them. p. 20-22.

Moreau de Bellain (a corresponding member), anxious to naturalize the cultivation of Siberian flax, had called the attention of the Society to the possibilities. Seeds had been obtained for them by Thouin. pp. 22-23.
