Tougard read a note on the multiplication of plants by means of their leaves; he had ~~received~~ received excellent results in experiments with leaves of Briophyllum calicinum. He also displayed to the Society a flowering stalk of Stapella hirsuta, an oriental plant which flowered rarely in northern latitudes. p. 32.

Gonfreville had discovered in 1830, amongst other dye-producing plants, one unknown at that time to France, the "Tagarey-Verrey". Tougard had sown seeds with good results. [No other name for this plant given]. p. 32.
