Notes Labillardiere had suggested at a meeting of the Institut in 1802, the advantages to be gained by cultivating Phormium tenax in France. He also said it could be naturalized in France. This is a report on the success in cultivation of a M. Cachin who had grown the plant to a height of 3 maters in his garden at Cherbourg.

Attempts in Paris by Gillet-Laumont & Thouin, Sept. 1822 had resulted in a production of plants from half the seeds planted.

of a new plant.
