Notes Alphonse de Candolle had been admitted as a foreign associate member; had offered his monograph on the Campanulaceae to the Society. p. xi.
Soyer-Willemet had discovered two new species of plants on which he had written two papers, one on the Erodium chium, which grew in the Pyrenees and in Corsica, but but which had hitherto been confused with a near species; he had then reviewed the species of Erodium in France. pp. xxiv. His 2nd paper was on Cerastium manticum not found before in France. Ended this with observations on the various species of Cerastium . p. xxiv.
Laurent had written a paper on chararhispidia. Short account pp. xxiv-xxv.
