Notes Extracted and translated from the Missionary Register by N. Perrin. On p. 171 the translator mentions that Hallbeck gives a list of the most useful kinds of trees. This is followed by a [verbatim?] translation of a paragraph on a small tree or shrub, called by the Boers "Wacht-y-Bitje", [literally "wait-a-bit"], a spiny plant causing man and animal to delay, whence the name. The paragraph is introduced by the statement: "If I were a botanist, I could make a long list of curious plants ..."

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
