Notes In the warm climate one often finds a mushroom which is produced on dead insects of the genus vespa and grillus. Dikson [sic] first described it by the name sphaeria entomorphiza. Found also on dead larvae of insects in Guadeloupe - Madiana has seen a live wasp with a mushroom of this kind on its sternum. Doubtful whether this happens with vigorous insects, but probable that larva in a frail state may be affected in this way. Sphaeria militaris of Persoon is another fungus which chooses the larva of insects to germinate on. Isaria sphingus covers the live hawk moth.
