Notes All except for the last paragraph, on p. 327, is in quotation marks, presumably quoted directly from W. Hamilton's letter. The last paragraph, [by Augustin N. Desvaux?], cites Hamilton as distinguishing between the Cuichunchulli of Bogotá, treated in this letter, which is said to be *Ionidium parviflorum*, and the two species brought from Cuanca and from Rio Bamba by Mercucius. Found growing in Puracé, district of Popayan, and in the environs of Bogotá and Enemocan, and originally described by Mutis as *Viola parviflora*, it has been renamed by Ventenat as *I. parviflorum*. The various specimens have also been examined by professor Juan-Maria Cespedes.
