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Notes ~~Both~~ Ephedra monostachya ~~and~~ is used among Kalmucks as a febrifuge and among the Russians of the Volga region in concocting an intoxicating and stimulating brew. The Kalmucks also use Aristolochia Clematis in an infusion against diseases of the skin in man and to promote healthy plumage in tame falcons. Native names given by Jähriq: Ephedra = sergena, or, among Mongolians, Osergana. Aristolochia, among Kalmucks, is known as Chum-musur-Oebössün.
