Included here because 3 varieties of watercress were distinguished by Bradberry:  
1) Green-leaved, 2) small brown leaved, 3) Large brown-leaved.  
They were not confined to any special type of water, since they could all be found growing together. They were all varieties of the same species, i.e. Nasturtium officinale, but they were not noticed as such in Hortus Kewensis, or in any other botanical book.
