Notes New plants in flower:

Rudbeckia ... new species, related closely to *R. triloba*, distinguished by its height, nearly 4 ft. and profusion of its flowers. - orig. N. America, ~~1800~~. brought back by Michaux.

Conisa ... new species; orig. temperate N. America. Brought back by Michaux. A shrub 5-6 ft. high, with brilliant yellow flowers.

Anthemis senecioides, Cav. Peru, sent by Cavanilles.

Begonia obliqua, Lin. Tropical - pale rose flowers.

Solanum triquetrum, Cav. Orig. middle America; sent by Cavanilles.

Sida mollissima, Ort. - Peru, seeds sent by Ortega.

Amellus pedunculatus, Ort. Spanish America - sent by Ortega.

Hedysarum fruticosum. - Siberia - Pallas.

Datura serrato caule - given by Radel - orig. believed to be Peru.

Madia viscosa, Cav. - new genus of corymb, sent by Cavanilles. Peru.

Over

Lachea minor, Lin. -orig. Pennsylvania, sent by William.

Eryngium dichotomum, Desf. - Barbary coast, brought back by Desfontaines.

Chelone barbata, Cav. -Peru, sent by Cavanilles.

Paspalum stoloniferum; this plant since being announced in part 33 (An 7) had produced seeds.

The article finished with observations on the genus.
