Clitoria heterophylla, Lin. Brought back from [^]Ile de Fr. by Cossigny.

Amarillis undulata, L. Had been at Museum for some time but had never flowered before.
Fr. Cape of Good Hope.

Achillea decumbens, Lamarck. Seeds sent by Brugière and Olivier from Asia.

Scabiosa parviflora, Flor. Atl. Orig. near Algiers. Seeds sent from Egypt by Nectoux.

Heterosperma pinnata, Cav. Orig. Peru, sent Cavanilles.

Hypericum crispum. Orig. N. America; br. back by Michaux.

Solanum nodiflorum, Jacq. From seeds br. back from [^]Ile de Fr.

Convolvulus biflorus, Lin. Orig. China.

Echium violaceum, Forskål. Egypt.

Echium creticum, Forskål. Seeds sent fr. Egypt by Nectoux.

Anoda parviflora, Cav. Orig. Mexico. Seeds sent by Cavanilles.

Over,

Dahlia rosea, Cav. Dedicated to Dahl. Orig. Mexico, but sent to Museum from Madrid by Thibaud.
Amomum zingiber, Lin. Grew in E. Indies. The best was grown in Malabar.
