 Plants mentioned: Pitcarnia Pitcairnia?, named after the English doctor Pitcairn from St. Thomas Island.
Echited biflora, from St. Thomas Island
Aletris fragrans, from Guinea. Cultivated in European gardens for more than a century it flowered rarely. Some botanical description. The plant was described and very well illustrated in Commelin's Hortus amstelodamsis.
Cleome gigantea, grew in Cayenne in the swamps. Seeds sent to the Museum by Aublet.
Epidendrum bifidum, from the Antilles.
Dracena [Dracoena?] ensifia, Linn.
Diana Silva-dea, Commerson; grew on trees in the Ile de France.
Guilandina Moningha.
